### INA Announces 2015 All-State Selections for Boys Basketball

The Iowa Newspaper Association announced its 2015 All-State Boys Basketball teams for Class 4A, 3A, 2A and 1A Tuesday, naming Sioux City North, Daniel Tillo as Mr. Basketball.

Daniel Tillo, a 6-5 senior forward from Sioux City North, led North to three consecutive state tournament appearances and finished his high school career with 2,016 points, joining former Mason City and University of Iowa star Jeff Horner in becoming the second athlete from a Class 4A school to crack the 2,000-point club.

Tillo averaged an even 21 points over 96 career games – breaking the all-time Sioux City high school record by more than 400 points. He averaged a Class 4A-leading 24.5 points this season after ranking second in the big-school division each of the last two seasons, averaging 21.6 as a junior and 22.5 as a sophomore. In addition to his team-high 9.0 rebounds a game, he led the Stars in assists with 98 while shooting converting three-point shots at a .438 clip (60 of 137), shooting .526 overall from the field and .783 (119 of 152) from the free throw line.
