The Iowa Newspaper Foundation's mission is to "champion and improve the quality and future of Iowa's newspaper enterprises and the communities they serve and to raise funds to fulfill this mission." Thanks to the work of the INF's Next Generation Task Force, eight Iowa newspapers will receive matching funds from the Foundation to host a paid student intern for eight weeks during the summer of 2022. Participating newspapers will be chosen after completing the application below and will be selected by a committee of peers. Preferential consideration will be given to those newspapers not awarded an INF internship the prior year.

The successful newspapers will interview and select their own student interns, and the INF will provide matching funds of \$1,000 to the selected newspapers.

AGREEMENT

A host newspaper receiving matching funds from the Iowa Newspaper Foundation agrees to the following:

The student intern will be paid a minimum of \$8/hour. Interns will work a minimum of 30 hours per week for eight weeks.

All funds received from the Iowa Newspaper Foundation will be used to pay the student intern.

All income taxes, Social Security and worker’s compensation costs will be paid by the newspaper (not from the funds provided by INF).

At the conclusion of the internship, the paper will provide the INF with a payroll report detailing the pay provided to the student intern. Host newspapers will also submit a follow-up report to INF summarizing the student’s responsibilities during the Internship, three things the student learned, etc.

Should the intern’s employment end any time prior to the scheduled time-frame, the newspaper must notify the INF and return all remaining funds to the INF at 319 East 5th Street, Des Moines, Iowa 50309.
